

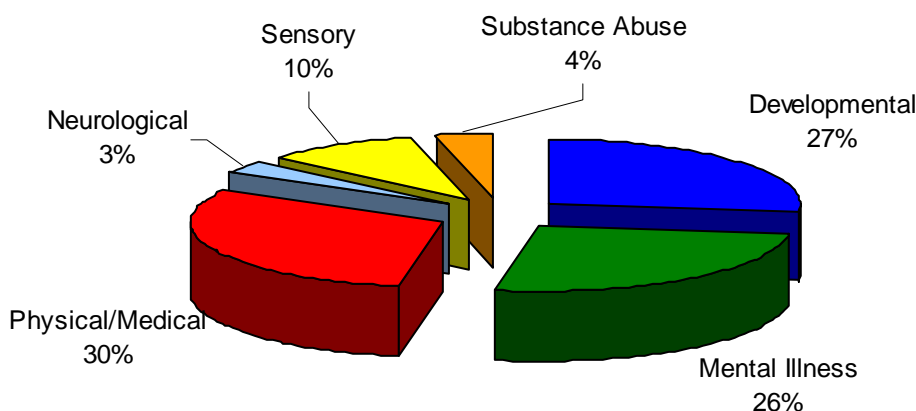
Outcomes for 2008

ServiceSource Network is comprised of four affiliate organizations: Abilities, headquartered in Florida, Employment Source, headquartered in North Carolina, OCI, headquartered in Delaware, and ServiceSource, headquartered in Virginia.



During the fiscal year 2008 the ServiceSource Network:

- Served over 11,700 people with disabilities in 10 states plus the District of Columbia
- Employed 1,206 people with disabilities as direct employees on AbilityOne contracts
- Placed 1,196 people in competitive positions with third party employers

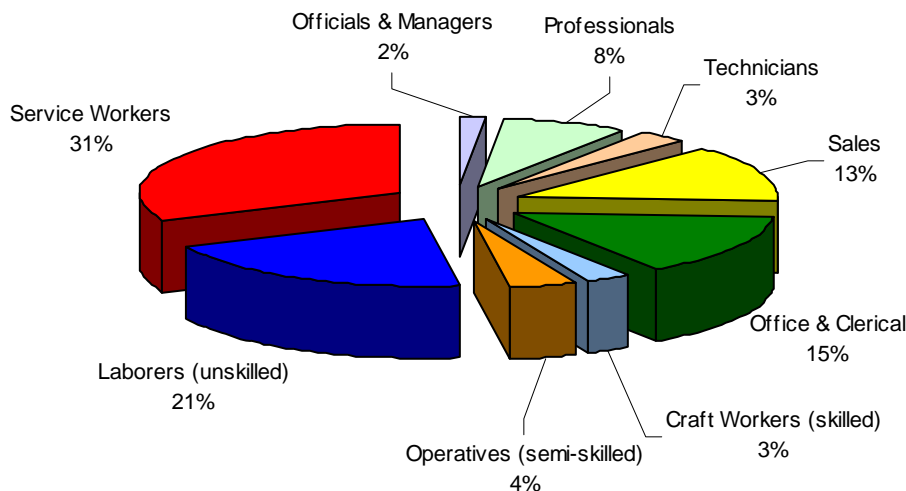


FY08 Primary Disabilities of Persons Served

In FY 2008 ServiceSource:

- Served 1,466 individuals with disabilities
- Employed 830 individuals with disabilities
- Placed 101 individuals with disabilities with third-party employers
- Raised \$300,000 in charitable giving through the ServiceSource Foundation that benefitted programs



Established in 1971, ServiceSource is a regional not-for-profit 501 (c)(3) that provides employment and training services for people with disabilities. ServiceSource has operations in Virginia, Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Colorado and the District of Columbia. ServiceSource is a nationally recognized leader within the disability field, providing quality jobs and support services to people with disabilities.



The ServiceSource Foundation funded a state-of-the-art Sensory Perception Center at the Woodmont CIC in FY 08.

Accomplishments in 2008:

- Awarded the AbilityOne consolidated remote delivery site mail operations contract that employs more than 80 people with disabilities
- Produced 5,231 Corpsman Assault Packs (CAPS) in support of our nation's military
- Expanded the AbilityOne nationwide Internal Revenue Service contract from 32 to 57 locations employing 126 people with disabilities
- Selected for the US Department of Agriculture's **Agency AbilityOne Award**
- Opened the Prince William Neighborhood Place to serve people in our Day Support Programs. Funding for the purchase of the building provided in full from the ServiceSource Foundation.

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
